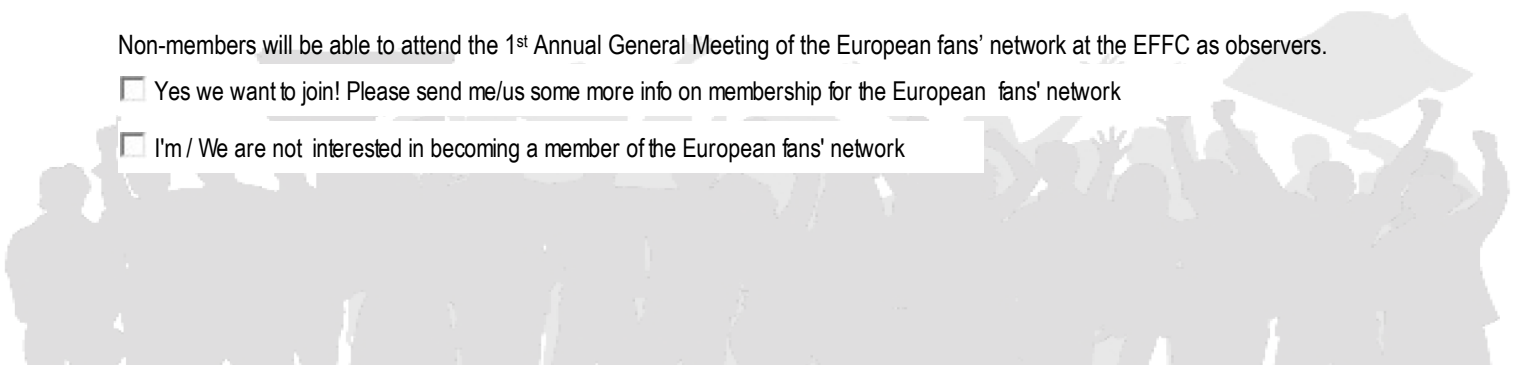
1st Annual General Meeting of the European fans' network (Sunday 19 July)
